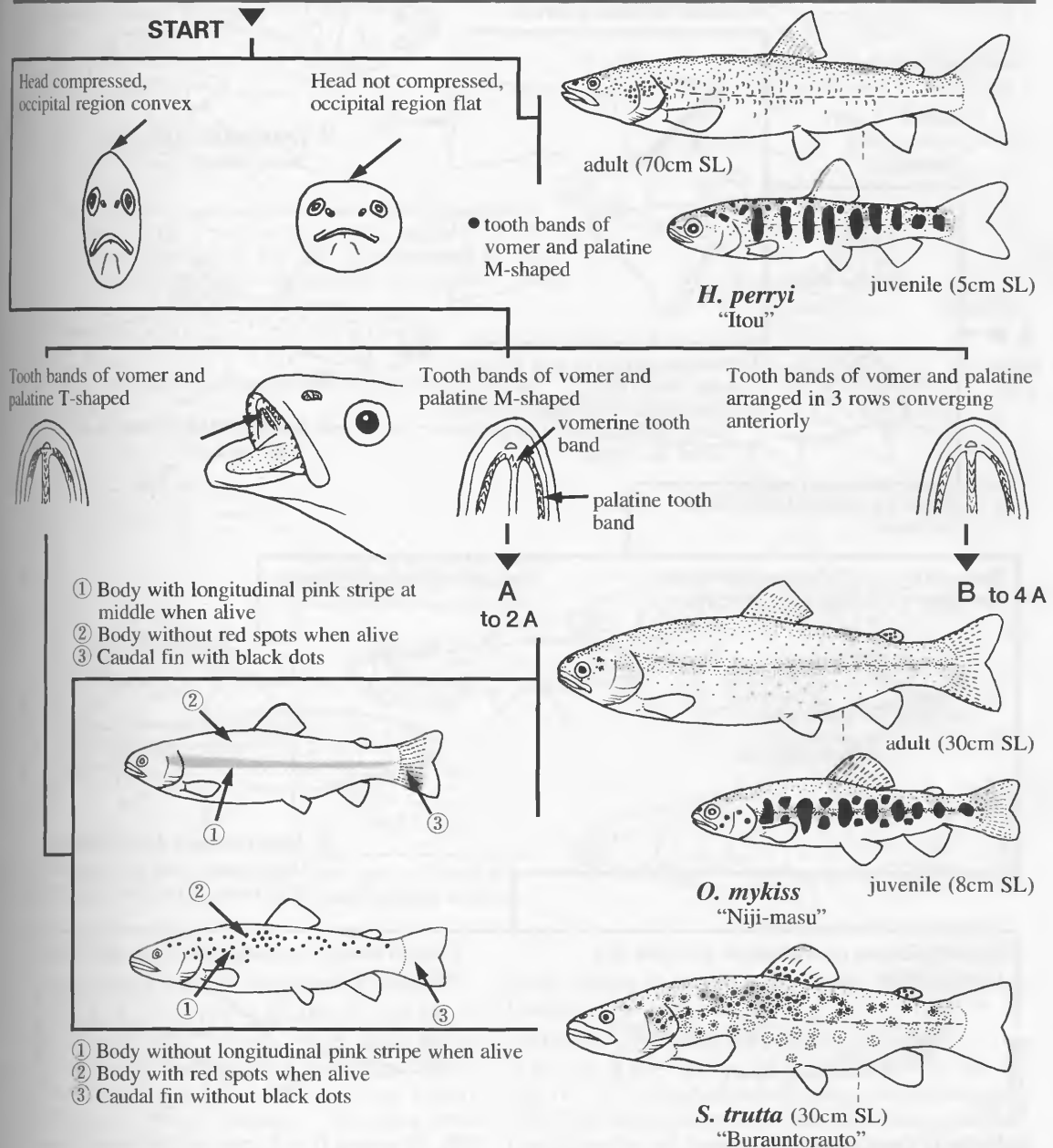


94. Salmonidae salmons

*Hucho perryi* (Brevoort)

D 9~12; A 9~10; LL 97~121; GR 15~20; PC 157~192. Lower reaches of rivers with wetlands, and lakes near sea waters. Partially migrating to sea. Hokkaido; southern Kurile Isls., Sakhalin, Primorsky Krai. Spawning from April to May.

Oncorhynchus mykiss (Walbaum)¹⁾

D 10~12; A 10~12; LL 125~150; GR 16~22; PC 53~69; Vert 60~66. Lentic waters of upper to middle reaches of rivers, clear lakes, reservoirs. Native to

Kamchatka, Alaska southward to California, where sea-run forms found. Introduced to Japan several times from U.S. Spawning from October to March.

Salmo trutta Linnaeus

D 9~14; A 9~12; LL 114~130; GR 14~19; PC 40~47; Vert 56~61. Lakes and rivers with cold, highly oxygenated waters. Colder waters than *O. mykiss* preferred. Originated from Europe. Introduced to Japan via U.S. during early Showa Era. Spawning from September to November.
